#1 Rehearsals of "Women of Note"

"Women of Note" was an Ottawa based predecessor to "The Secret Furies." There were three Nova Scotia based women in "Women of Note," Anne Bishop, Barbara MacDonald and Pat Brennan. All returned to NS, where Anne sang in "Lysistrata" and "The Secret Furies," Pat in "The Women Next Door." Pat's brilliant re-written lyrics for popular songs were sung by all four groups.

Side A: The Underground Railroad; Listen to the Voices; Freedom has Beckoned; Justice and Peace (Pat Brennan lyrics); La Andina (cut off before the end)

Side B: Still Ain't Satisfied; Listen to the Voices; Still Ain't Satisfied (a better version)

After "Women of Note" the tape goes into Heather Bishop's recording of "Yukon Rain."
