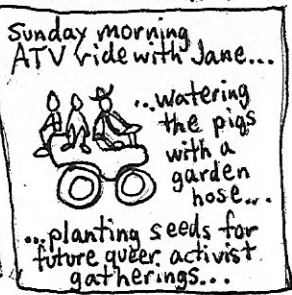
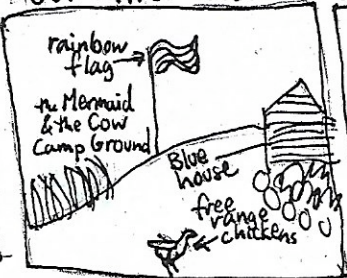

- community campfire

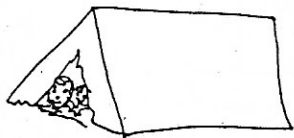

Cost: \$10 per person for the whole weekend plus 25\$ per tent/night campground fee.

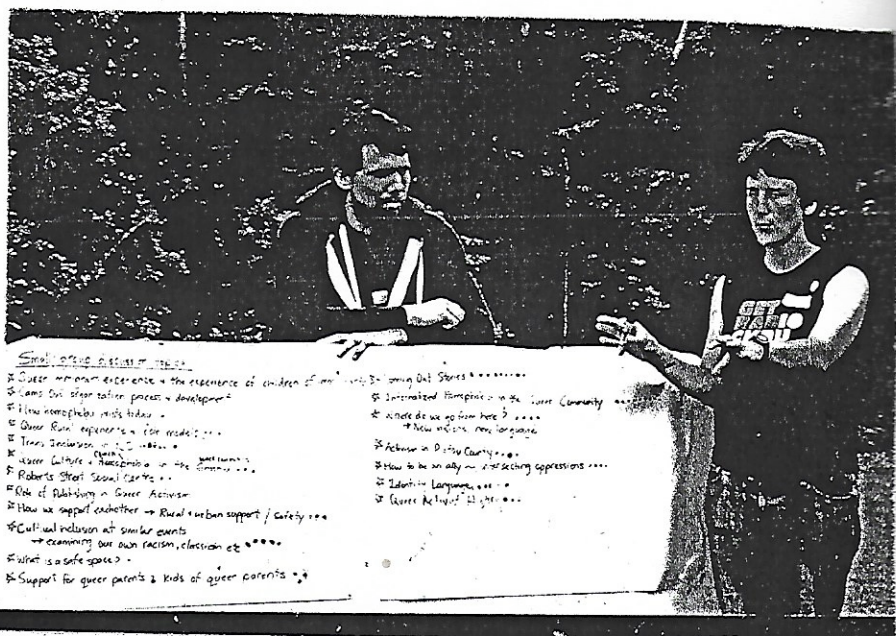
