PROPOSAL:

We, Gay and Lesbian Christians of Halifax, propose, with the approval and support of Rumours' Manager and Staff, and the GAE, to organize a Food Drive during the month of February at the club RUMOURS. The food will be donated, via GAE, to the Metro Foodbank, on behalf of the Gay and Lesbian Community of Halifax, with the agreement that these foods be distributed to needy people in the Gottingen St. area.
