

1. Attached is the Pride Parade route map, courtesy of Scott Marquardt.
2. There will be a reserved designated parade viewing area located beside CBC, open to all parade watchers with mobility concerns.
3. There is a low-ride bus being made available to any Elderberry and 50+ person who would like to participate in the parade. Participants must be at the start of the parade (dockyard parking - where Upper Water Street meets Barrington) and on the bus by 1:00 pm.

#### 4. Elderberries Gathering

In the Pride Festival area, after the parade, there will be an area reserved for seniors and people with mobility issues. This area will open after the parade finishes, and will be open until the last person leaves. The Pride Committee has arranged special facilities for us there, including :

- "Elderberries Gathering" sign
- relaxing atmosphere with artificial trees for shade, and flower arrangement courtesy of Neville MacKay
- sofa, chairs, and tables
- accessible washroom, dedicated to the Elderberries and VIPs
- free drinking water and snacks
- glassware (rather than plastic)
- table provided for our brochure
- possible dedicated server for beverages

We do not have a map of the "Elderberries Gathering" area, but it is near the VIP section and the bar. Watch for the sign!

This relaxing area is not meant for Elderberries members alone : please feel free to bring along any 50+ friends who might enjoy it. Possibly an attempt might be made to sign them up for Elderberries....
