Food & Drink: There'll be tea and light refreshments waiting for you. If you'd like to bring something to share, please do. It doesn't have to be fancy or expensive.

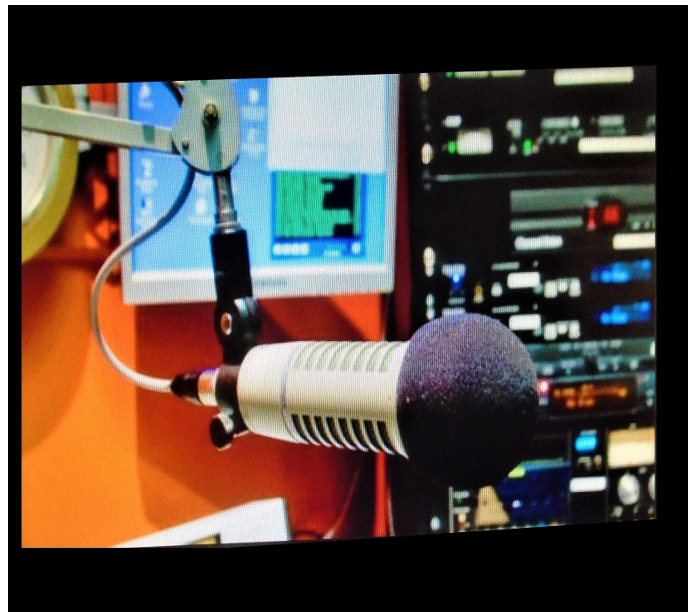
