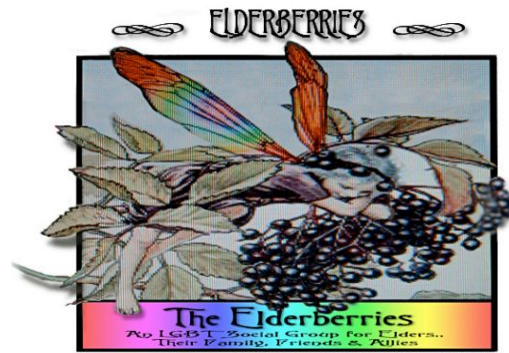

Longtime Elderberries member Patricia Martinson is the poster girl for The Sea In Her Blood, the current exhibit at the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic. From Martinson's 96 to teenager Stella Bowles, the exhibit has a broad range of women who have different connections to the sea. There are activists, artists, scientists, members of the Royal Canadian Navy, women in the fisheries and more. There are Acadian, African Nova Scotian and Mi'kmaq women.

The exhibit opened last Friday and is open until February 2020.

7 - Elderberries Mugs Are Back!

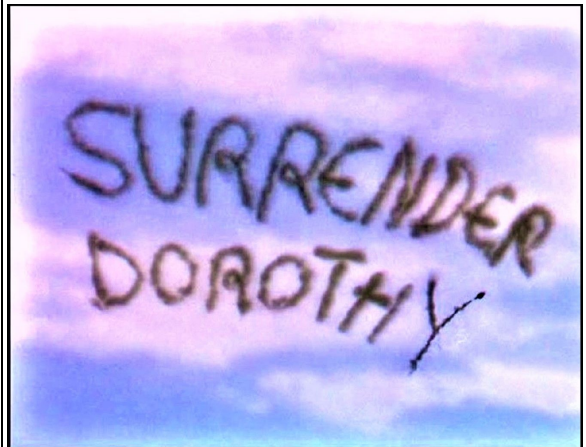
