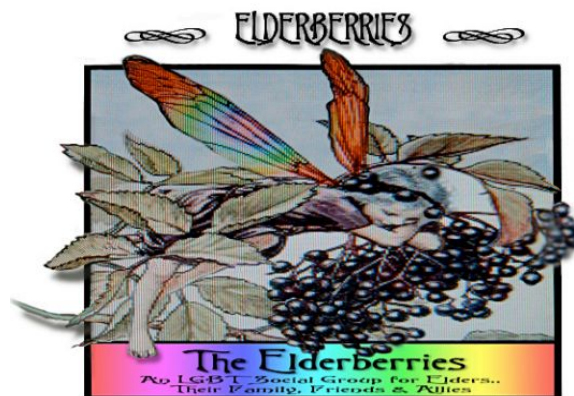

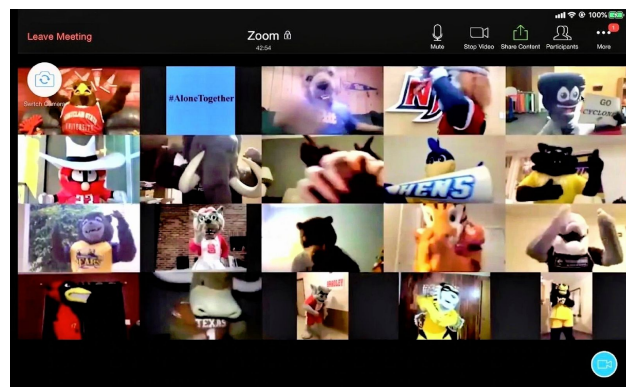

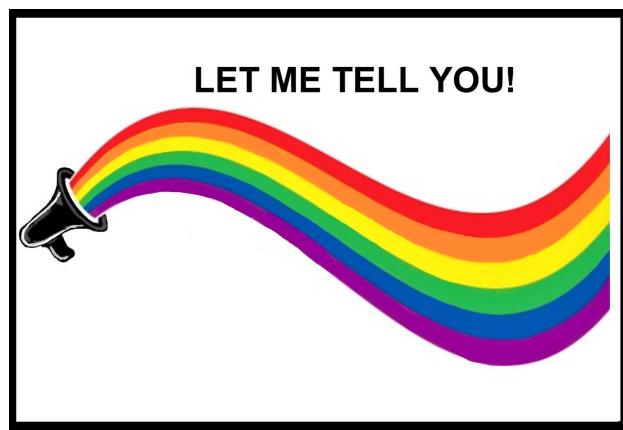


4 – Isolation Time History Work!
