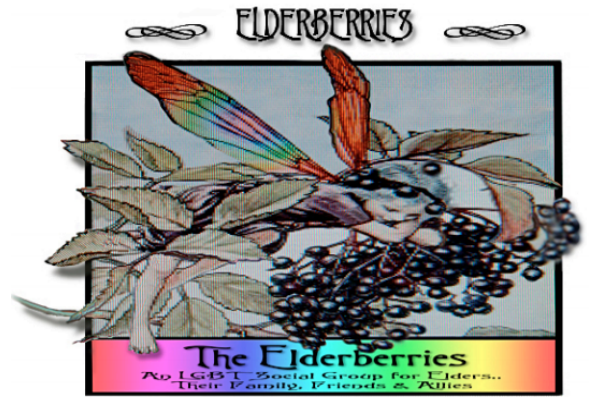

4 Isolation Time History Work!

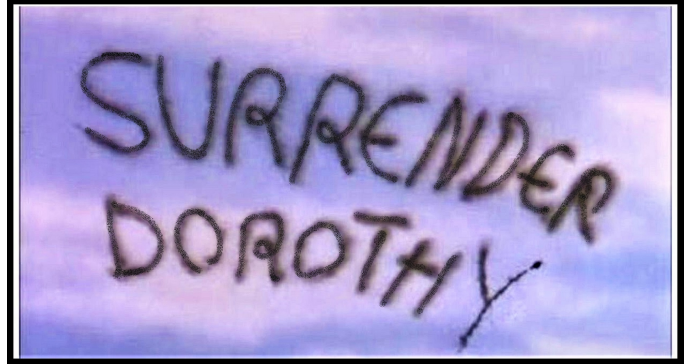
