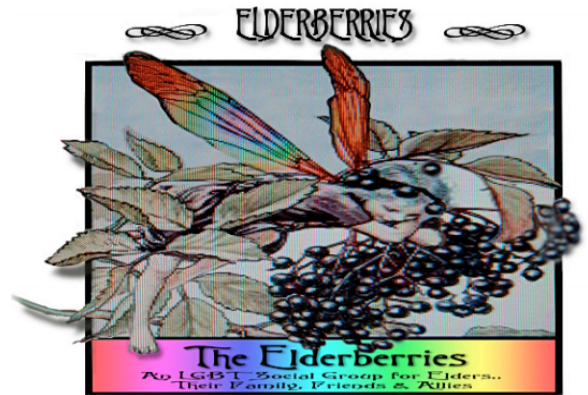

## 1. September 10th Picnic

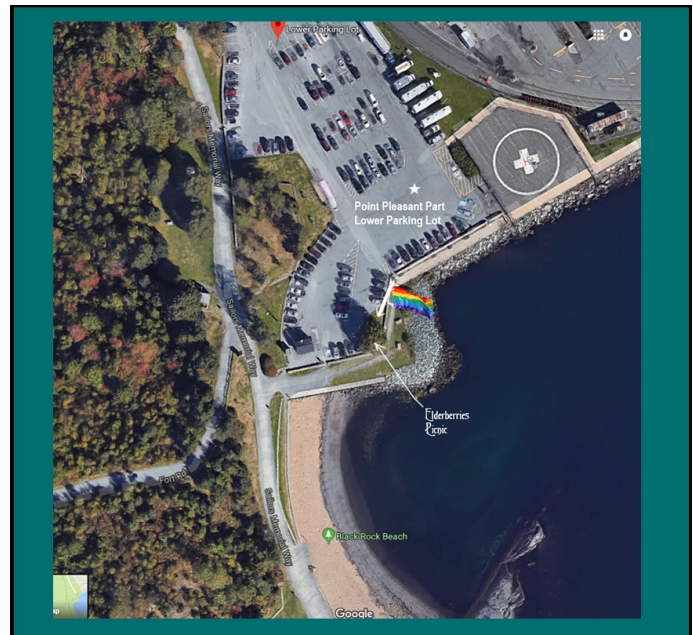
**Where: Point Pleasant Park off the Lower Parking Lot by Black Rock Beach**

Come and go when you please. Porta potties are nearby.

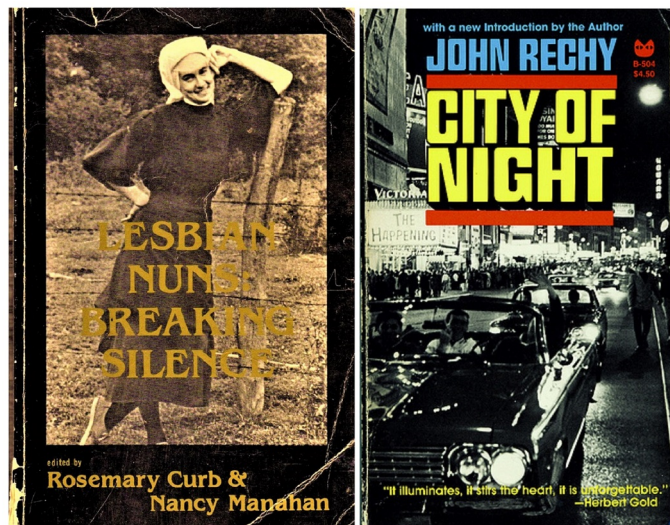
NOTE: Let Metro Transit know you'd like the #29 bus stop restored to the lower parking lot. This will help a lot of folks who have physical challenges.



## 2. Isolation Time History Work

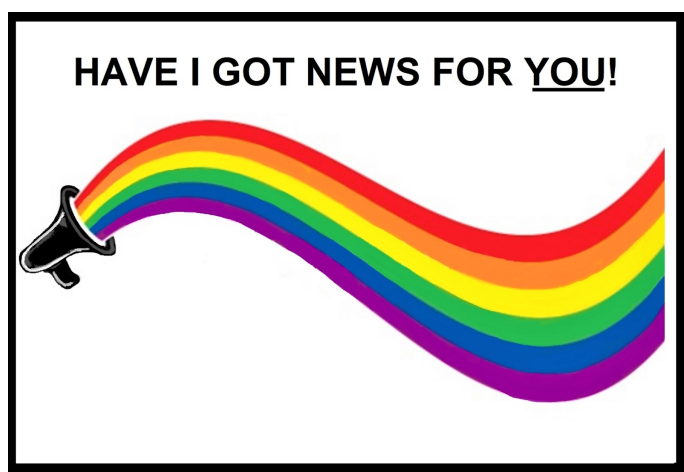
