

What: Musical performance! RSVP! and potluck finger food. Special instructions below!


Where: Northwood; use the 2630 Gottingen St. door.

Marking the day after Remembrance Day, composer-lyricist Garry Williams will perform musical excerpts from KAMP, a musical set in the homosexual isolation barracks of the Nazi concentration camp Sachsenhausen. KAMP ran to sold-out houses at Neptune in 2018.

As the title suggests, the piece is an hommage to camp, telling a story of resistance, community, and queer identity in the face of persecution, forced labour, torture, and extermination through labour.


