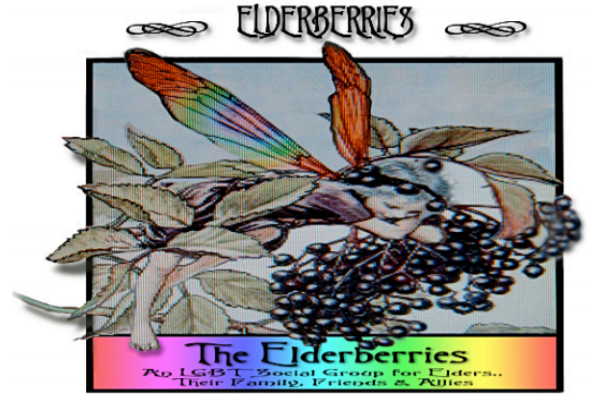

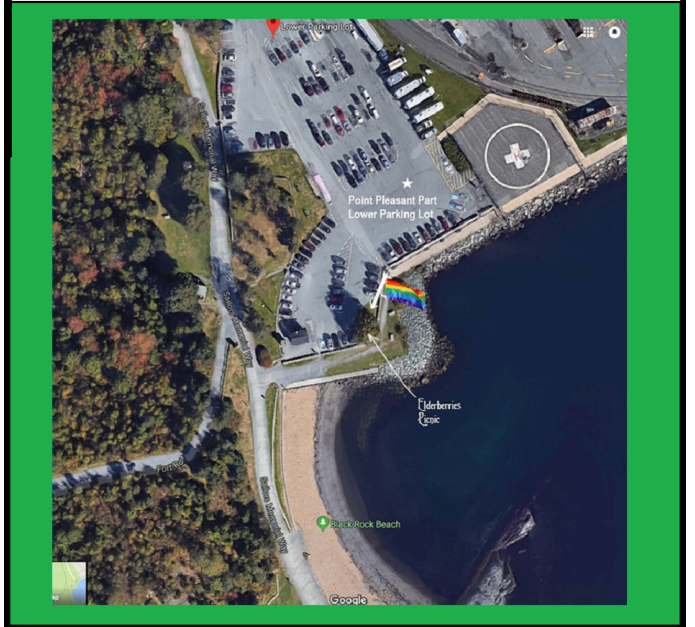
1. Our September Picnic
