

1.May 11th Salon

When: Sunday May 11th, 1 PM - 3 PM Where: 2630 Gottingen St.Halifax What: Advocating for Trans rights

South of the border, executive orders (some being challenged by the courts) have peeled away trans and gay person's rights to serve in the military. Gender affirming care for youth has been banned in several states. Books by gay and black authors have been removed from many schools. 49 out of 50 states are considering laws limiting the rights of gay and trans individuals.

Some of these laws have already passed. Will this trend pass to Canada? Or is it already here?

The International Day against Homophobia, Biphobia and Transphobia is May 17th. We are marking it in advance with a talk by Mica Daurie, founder of Transgender/Non-Binary Rights Advocacy NS.



This local consulting and educational firm is also concerned with helping queer people stand up for our rights. Join us for insights into the need for Trans advocacy here and now. Venus Envy bookseller Marshall Heywood will emcee this free program.


