

You're not alone. Over seventy percent of people have anxiety about public speaking. But many members of our Speakers' Bureau have overcome it. So can you.

In this time of creeping homophobia and transphobia we need elders who can speak out both about the Bad Old Days, and about the current struggles of the 2SLGBTQ+ community.

Anxious Elderberries and friends are invited to join us for an Elderberries Salon on Sunday June 22 at Northwood Adult Day Space, 2630 Gotttingen Street, at 1:00 pm. Heather Perkins,



a woman so keen on public speaking that she belongs to three Toastmasters Clubs, will tell us about "Overcoming your fear of public speaking."

This free talk is brought to you by the Elderberries Speakers' Bureau, who are eager to meet both experienced and newly inspired people. But you don't have to join the Speakers' Bureau to take part – this event is open to all.

Joseph Sciarocco, a television producer with the new local 2SLGBTQ+ related program Out East will also be with us, interviewing for an episode on Elderberries to be shown in the fall. Seats out of camera range will be available for those not ready for prime time. Please note our early start, to accommodate filming.

3. May 11th Salon

Emcee Marshall Hayward of Venus Envy introduced Mica Daurie to discuss advocating for trans rights.

Mica spoke about growing concerns over challenges to trans folks' rights. She debunked false accusations about adolescents forced to transition and rape accusations, using statistics. In free discussion, the fear of and reluctance to be socially visible were discussed. She claimed that attacking trans rights is a litmus test before dismantling queer rights.




4. Isolation Time Homework
