

3. June 8 Board Games Salon

On June 8, members met at Rumours HFX for board games. But we never got to that! We fell into catching up and chatting and trying out a special drink that the Rumours bartender had created for us using Elderflower Cordial.



4. June 22nd Salon

We had two things going on at the same time on June 22nd.

Heather Perkins, of Toastmasters, gave a talk on "Overcoming your fear of public speaking" to an audience composed mostly of members and prospective members of the Elderberries Speakers' Bureau, which sponsored her appearance. She addressed presenting oneself with confidence, advance preparation, supporting each point as it is made, and avoiding overdependence on technology. Bearing in mind that the Speakers' Bureau usually goes out as a team, she touched briefly on group as well as individual presentations.

Heather outlined the various formats of public speaking: persuasive, educational, entertainment etc and the different ways you engage your audience for each one, and answered lots of questions.



At the same time, a crew from Winter Light Productions, which is making a documentary series on LGBT folk in Atlantic Canada, was doing interviews with the Elderberries members who were present.

Need a cosy gift? Elderberries mugs are perfect.


